A LOOK AHEAD

Can you believe the season is winding down already? After our July 5 meet at Crestwood, the last dual meet is **July 14** against Chesterfield/Ellisville/Wildwood (diving will be against Clayton) at Webster.

The Junior Swim Team meet will be held at the morning practice, beginning promptly at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, **July 14**. Any participant who began on Junior Team, even if (s)he has since moved up, is eligible for this meet. Events are freestyle, backstroke and breast stroke in heats of three, in addition to a couple of fun events. Ribbons will go to all swimmers. We'll recruit volunteers from parents at the meet (timers, ribbon writers, runners.) Coaches Patty and Brigid have done a great job improving swimming skills, increasing endurance and preparing these kids for competition.
